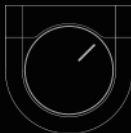

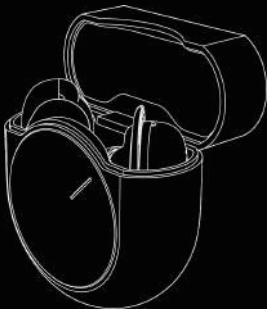

Power On/Off



Power On: The earbuds will automatically turn on, on opening the charging case.

Power Off: The earbuds will automatically turn off once placed inside the charging case with the lid closed.

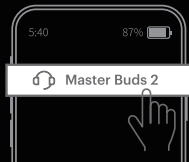
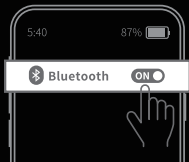
Pairing

After Powering On for the first time, Master Buds 2 will automatically enter pairing mode and the white LED will start breathing. Search and select Master Buds 2 from the list of available Bluetooth devices. Once the connection is successful, the light will turn off.

Your Master Buds 2 are now paired with your device and ready to use.

Pressing and holding the charging case button for 3s is another way to bring the device into pairing mode.

Note: Your Master Buds 2 will automatically connect to the last paired device as soon as it is powered on.



Reset / Clear the earbuds device list

1. Make sure your earbuds are fully charged.
2. On your paired devices, delete/remove Noise Master Buds 2 from the list of paired devices in the Bluetooth menu
3. Insert both earbuds into the charging case and long press the charging case button for 15 seconds
4. The Orange LED on the charging case will start blinking, to indicate earbuds have been reset.

Choosing your eartip & earwing size

Earbuds are fitted with medium-sized tips. However, if you find that they don't fit perfectly, please remove them and try the combinations of small and large eartips and earwings.

Note: Master Buds 2 comes with 9 different combinations of eartips and earwings to match your personal fit and comfort.



Charging

Earbuds

Place both earbuds inside the case to charge them.

Indication (on case)

- White LED Blink and then OFF = Charging

CHECK THE EARBUD BATTERY LIFE

While using the earbuds

- When you remove the earbuds from the charging case and insert them into your ears, a voice prompt announces the earbud battery level when battery is low.
- Use the Noise Audio APP. The earbud battery level is displayed on the main screen.

CHARGING (Case)

Charge the case via the supplied Type-C charging cable, preferably from any PC or laptop as compared to a USB charger.

Indication (on case)

- Orange LED Stay = Charging

Clean the earbuds and charging case

Component	Cleaning instructions
Eartips & Earwings	Remove the eartips & earwings from the earbuds and wash them with mild detergent and water. Note: Make sure you thoroughly rinse and dry the eartips & earwings before re-attaching them to the earbuds.
Earbud nozzles	Wipe only with a dry, soft cotton swab or equivalent. Caution: Never insert any cleaning tool into the nozzle.
Charging contacts (on earbuds)	To prevent corrosion, wipe with a dry, soft cotton swab or equivalent.
Charging case	Wipe only with a dry, soft cotton swab or equivalent.

Sidetone

Sidetone lets you hear your own voice through your headset while you talk. This helps you speak at a normal, comfortable volume instead of accidentally shouting during your calls.

Motion Control

Control your music and call effortlessly with simple head movements, just a nod or shake to answer, reject, or manage playback, completely hands-free.

- **Left and Back:** Turn your head left and return to the center twice to skip to the previous track.
- **Right and Back:** Turn your head right and return to the center twice to skip to the next track.
- **Nod:** Nod your head up and down twice to play/pause audio or answer a call.
- **Head Shake:** Shake your head left and right twice to reject an incoming call.

The warranty covers your Noise product, including accessories, against manufacturing defects (if any) for 1 year from the date of purchase.

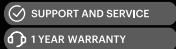
Things that are not covered in the warranty are listed below:
